Updated Win-E-Mac Football Spectator Policy (Updated 10/26/20)

Due to increased COVID numbers throughout Polk County and with multiple sporting events this week against other Polk County schools, we continue to review our spectator policy as a continued effort to ensure the completion of our seasons.

- 1. Players, Personnel, and cheerleaders will be allowed tickets for household members (parents, stepparents, guardians, siblings) (no sharing of tickets).
- 2. The Coaches' parents and household members will be allowed tickets.
- 3. Remaining tickets will be open for students (7-12) and staff to claim on Wednesday morning (Google Doc).
 - Students are only able to claim one ticket to be used for themselves.
 - Staff may claim up to two tickets to be used for members of their household.
- 4. For this week there will be NO community access to claim tickets. Please watch us on GVTV, the GVTV streaming option, or listen on the radio.
 - WEM staff will have a list at the gate for all claimed tickets. Please try to pay in exact change, to limit the amount of contact. There will be NO purchasing of tickets on game day, all tickets have to be claimed prior.
 - Ticket Prices: Adults (\$6.00), Student (\$4.00), Senior Citizen (\$4.00), WEM Staff (\$4.00), and WEM Students (\$2.00).

JV Game (10/26)

- No claiming of tickets/passes needed, but only parents, students, and staff members should be attending Monday's JV game vs. CG as well.
- Like usual, there is no cost for admittance to the JV game.

Game Day Guidelines:

- Spectators are expected to socially distance and wear a facemask covering your nose and mouth.
- It is encouraged to bring your own chair. Bleacher seating will be reduced.
- All spectators, children included, are expected to watch the football game.
- There will not be any concessions.
- No access to the school will be allowed for spectators (porta-potties will be the only bathrooms).

Win-E-Mac Volleyball Spectator Policy (Updated 10/26)

- 1. Only 2 household members will be allowed per player (No sharing of tickets).
- 2. Please enter through Door 1.
- 3. Please exit through Door 19 (Arts & Events Center Door) (after varsity game, exit through the commons)
- 4. Masks must be worn properly covering the mouth and nose at all times.
- 5. No spectators are allowed to sit on the east side of the gym (players only)
- 6. The west side of the gym has been marked for visiting and home spectators.
- 6. Family/spectators will sit at least 6 ft. from another family-spectator group.
- 7. There WILL NOT be concessions.
- 8. Immediately after the game, fans are expected to move outside and not congregate on the floor.
- 9. You must leave promptly after the conclusion of your daughter's game, you may not stay for additional games which she doesn't participate in. THIS INCLUDES THE VARSITY GAME.
- 10. Spectators for JV or V games, if you are arriving before the conclusion of the previous game, please wait in your cars until you see the spectators from the previous game leaving from Door 19.
- 11. Ticket prices are \$6.00 (Adults), \$4.00 (student, senior citizen, WEM staff), \$2.00 (WEM student)
