#### **Christmas Tree Wall hanging or Christmas Tree Runner**

#### 4' TREE WALL HANGING Finished size 24" BY 56"

Background (white on white is good) 7/8 yard

Border and Binding (I did my border and binding) in red 1 yard WOF OR 1 5/8 yd cut lengthwise

**Tree-** 15 fabrics - 1/8 yard or I used a jelly roll in greens (1 jelly roll make 2- 4' trees)

Center Diamonds- dark green (again I used darkest strips in jelly roll yard) otherwise 1/8 yard

Trunk- 1/8 yard

#### TABLE RUNNER - Finished size 16" by 38" (unless you choose a larger middle of background fabric)

Tree- 1/4 vd OR Jelly roll (jelly roll makes a bit more than 2 table runners)

Center Diamonds- 1/8 yd or 3' x WOF

Trunk- 8" square scrap

**Background-** 5/8 yard or 3/4 if you want a longer table runner that 38"

Border and Binding- 1/2 yd

If you need me to pick you up a Jelly Roll you will need to call me by NOVEMBER 10 as it will have to be shipped to me cost will be \$ 24.99 plus shipping. if you share with someone you will split the cost BUT you will need to find someone to share with. But I am pretty sure you will want to make more than one!! You must bring your own sewing machine, thread, rotary cutter, ruler pins, and any other things you need to sew with. I will have the special items needed for making the tree and runner.

Do you have a Cricut and want to do more with it or are you thinking of getting a Cricut and are curious as to what you can do with it?

We will get to know about design space, and I will explain what I know about Cricut access. Will show how to use HTV (heat transfer vinyl), 631 (for stenciling), 651 (removable vinyl) and cardstock.

If you have a Cricut, please bring to class along with your laptop computer and your Cricut tools (weeder, brayer if you have and a green mat) If just checking it out to see if you want one, we can share mine.

We will cut a HTV vinyl design for a hand towel, use 631to cut design for a glass block and transfer using transfer tape, and also make a simple card.
