



## Pinocchio! at Win-E-Mac School: FAQs

- 1. When are rehearsals?** Rehearsals (for students entering 3rd through 9th grades) will be from **10:00 to 3:00 on Monday, August 4th, through Friday, August 8th.** Rehearsals will take place on the stage in the Arts & Event Center.
- 2. When is the performance?** The public performance will be **August 8th, starting at 7:00 p.m.** The performance will also be in the Arts & Event Center.
- 3. Who is running it?** Rehearsals will be run by Summer Arts Stages staff, but I (Andrew Hanson) can continue to be a point of contact throughout.
- 4. Does my child need to be there the whole day?** In short, yes. SAS staff will work with students in small and large groups, so they should never be bored!
- 5. What if I cannot commit to the whole week?** It would be pretty difficult to jump in and catch up mid-way through just one week of rehearsals, so it will be important to be present every day. However, I *might* be able to find something for you to do behind the scenes, if you are interested in some crew work later in the week.
- 6. Do I need to pack lunch for my child?** Win-E-Mac serves free lunches for students throughout the summer, so that will not be necessary! Students will break for lunch Mon-Thurs (not Fri) at noon (lunch is served from 11 to 1).

7. **Does my child need to prepare for an audition?** While auditions for parts will happen, there is no need to prepare a monologue or music for an audition.
8. **Is there a cost to participate?** This summer musical program is *almost entirely* grant-funded. However, there will be a nominal cost for students to participate: **\$5 for WEM students, \$10 for non-WEM students.** (Payments can be given to Erin in the front office or to Andrew Hanson.)
9. **Can students from other districts participate?** Yes! This is my most-asked question. While there is a higher cost (see previous question), we want to welcome students from the whole region, not just WEM school district.
10. **Are there t-shirts available for purchase?** Yes, there will be! Stages sells the shirts of the show each season for \$15 if the students want one. This year they are a nice orange with purple ink. They would bring cash or a check to Stages.
